

WASHINGTON 4-H CAMP MANAGEMENT GROUP

Position Description/Expectations

The members of the Washington State 4-H Camp Management Group will be assembled to assist in the development of a statewide 4-H camping program. The duties of this group will include, but not be limited to, the following tasks:

- A) Define role of the group, operating practices such as terms of members, rotation schedule and scope of work
- B) Assist in creating a safe, educational camp environment for the youth of Washington State 4-H
- C) Establish and implement a program plan for Washington State 4-H Camps
- D) The group should be made of an equal number from each of the four WSU Cooperative Extension Districts and should consist of: 3 WSU Extension Staff, 3 County Program Staff, 2 unpaid resident camp staff, 2 paid resident camp staff, 2 youth counselor, 1 state staff representative.
