- 1. Is thinning and spacing good spacing for crop?
- 2. Are weeds less than 10 per 3' of row?

Questions

- 1. Name the Native American 3 sisters. Corn, beans, & squash.
- 2. Do you know why? The Three Sisters, corn, beans, and squash, have been planted by traditional Native American gardeners in many different regions of North America, although many different Native American people have adopted this traditional gardening technique, it originated with the Haudenosaunee (hah-dee-no-show-nee), or "People of the Long house".
 - The traditional Three Sisters garden forms an ecosystem by creating a community of plants and animals. This system creates a beneficial relationship between the three plants; each plant helps the others grow. This is a form of companion planting.
- 3. Describe 3 kinds of cool season root crops. Beets, Carrots, Potatoes, Radishes, Turnips.
- 4. Describe 3 kinds of warm season crops. Tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, beans, corn, squash, cucumbers, melons, and pumpkins.
