2017 Sheep/Goat Pre-show / Weigh-in Date

The Sheep and Goat pre-show / weigh-in will be held on Sunday, June 11 from 3pm to 7pm at the Klickitat County Fairgrounds. 4-H members who plan to sell a market lamb or goat in the 2017 Klickitat County Fair Market Livestock Sale must be enrolled in 4-H through the 4-H Online (https://wa.4honline.com) prior to the June 11 weigh-in date. See additional instructions for 4-H Online in the May issue of the 4-H Focus online. Call the Extension office at 509-773-5817 you have any questions.

Shearing for lambs will be available. The shearing fee per lamb will be deducted from the market sale check for that youth.

Reminder: Animals acquired outside of Washington should be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection done prior to coming into the state. For complete information, view the WSDA resources page at http://agr.wa.gov/FoodAnimal/AvianHealth/Fairs.aspx.

Be sure to have your completed "2017 Official Market Livestock Pre-Show Entry Form" correctly filled out for each animal being weighed. The form also has the minimum and maximum weights information for the large animal species. The form is available at the Extension office as well as online at http://extension.wsu.edu/klickitat/4h/4-h-recordkeeping/.

Judging is making a decision and telling why that decision is made. Judging competitions allow youth to compare two or more items and explain why they think one is better than the other. The main purpose behind judging contests and activities is to help teach decision-making skills.

At each stop, participants will be able to judge different species and will give oral reasons on two species/classes that day, expanding their skills and knowledge in judging. This will be a fun learning experience. Bio-security measures will also be practiced at each location, upon arrival and at departure.

Youth must have a responsible adult driver all day (must be a parent/guardian or club/group leader). Please bring a sack lunch, curiosity to learn and plan to have a great, fun-filled day. Winners of the Volunteer Excellence Awards (lifetime achievement and less than 10 Years) will be sent on for National Competition. Award winners will be recognized at the annual WA State 4-H Leaders' Forum in October 2015.
