- 10. What town is the San Juan County Extension Office/4-H headquarters located? (Friday Harbor, WA – San Juan Island)
- 11. What do the 4-H emblem, Smokey the Bear, the Red Cross, the Olympic Rings and the Presidential Seal all have in common?

- 12. Where is the Washington State 4-H Fair held? (Puyallup, WA)
