This training and certification meets the educational training requirements to serve as a 4-H Shooting Sports volunteer leader in Washington State. In accordance with state policies, 4-H Shooting Sports instructors at the county level must fulfill the following requirements:

- Minimum 21 years of age (18 years old for assistant instructors)
- Be screened, trained, and enrolled as current 4-H Volunteers through their local County Ext. offices
- Be trained and certified for each discipline (Rifle, Archery) that they are teaching at the county level
- Have successfully completed a minimum of 11 hours of Extension approved/sanctioned instructor-training, which includes an online session via Zoom on Tuesday evening, September 20th, 6:30 9:00 p.m. Training certificates will not be released unless this classroom session has been attended.

Training Information:

The Zoom session online does not require you to download any program. You will receive a link to connect you to the training. If you have a camera and microphone with your computer, you can connect that way. If not, you can connect to the discussion by phone.

The in-person trainings focus on how to lead a 4-H archery or riflery project, not how to hit the bullseye every time. Please do not expect to get a lot of target practice.

Trainings will be indoors.

Instructor will be 4-H volunteer Matt Tuttle. (Thanks, Matt!)

What to Bring:

Note pad and pen

Snack, favorite (appropriate) beverage

For riflery, bring eye protection of some kind, but not dark glasses. If you wear eyeglasses, it is not necessary to wear additional protection over the top of your glasses. All other equipment will be provided by the instructor.

For archery, if you have your own finger tabs and arm guard, feel free to bring them, but all equipment will be provided by the instructor in any case.

Lunch will be provided. If you have special dietary needs, consider bringing your own munchies.
