At the beginning of each year leaders, members, and parents should agree on expectations for member participation in the club. The following is a list of suggested topics for your club discussion.

- Attend a certain number of club meetings.
- Attend a certain number of project meetings.
- Serve as a committee member or officer.
- Do a public presentation.
- Keep a record book.
- Learn new skills and knowledge.
- Have an exhibit.
- Work on a community service project.
- Do leadership activities.
- Participate in an out-of-club activity such as camp or conference.
- Be Creative. (This is the leader's and member's opportunity to think of other things that could contribute to the 4-H experience.)
