

ASOTIN COUNTY FAIRBOARD

April 19, 2017 - Regular Meeting

6:31 p.m. meeting called to Order.

Members present: Shan Bonson, Mackenzie Welch, Ron Hostetler, Cindy Harrison, Barb Appleford, Peggy Hansford, Arlene Mullins, Kelly Longfellow, and Jamie Renzelman. Junior Fairboard Member: Tylor Nicol. Ron moved to excuse Steve Mullins and Byron Harrison. Shan seconded, motion carried.

Minutes for April 12, 2017 drafted by Mackenzie Welch were approved as corrected.

Treasurer's Report: No bills.

Open to the Public:

Doug Jones: They are getting the pens together and have made significant progress. He got Idaho Forest Group to donate the 2 x 12's to go on the pens for tack boxes. He got Fastenal's to donate the clamps and screws for putting the boards on.

Committee Reports:

Kelly Longfellow: She is working on the final draft for the rodeo program. She will get Shan the number for how many comp tickets we need. Roger's bought our flag girls their shirts, so they will be the RMX flag girls this year. The saloon is coming along nicely. Local entries are closed. Cannot take anymore mutton busting, but may be able to take others. Dan Centenari was able to secure a loading chute for us. She is still having trouble accessing the arena rental schedule. The Buds Cook Shack Sign and Hells Canyon Rodeo Signs are back up – thank you to Coca Cola. Royalty is in charge of the Queen's luncheon. Paving in front of the bleachers was completed by Morgan Industries and looks fabulous.

Jamie Renzelman: All scavenger hunt prizes are in. Spot On donated 7 10% off coupons; Ricardo's donated 3 7" pizzas; Hoppers donated 3 2 topping large pizzas; Jack in the Box donated 27 free Jumbo Jacks with the purchase of a large drink; Happy Day donated 10 \$5 gift cards; and As You Like It Cake's donated 18 cupcakes. Evan Southwick advised Jamie that we need to mow the camper spots on the upper level. Dan Anderson asked if their camper spot could be moved down and they be allowed to bring a 4-wheeler to transport Jackson and Kolsi. Barb moved that we allow Dan Anderson to bring a 4-wheeler. Shan seconded, motion carried.

Barb Appleford: We are still short a few trophies. Wants to put up 20 sheets of OSB on other side of new swine pen area and paint both walls brown. Ron motioned we allow Barb to do so if she can get it donated. Arlene seconded, motion carried.

Arlene Mullins: Tiffany Gilmore called with Starkids Daycare. She needs to provide us with a list of all the kids and supervisors that will be coming to the fair, along with the day and times they will be there. Adult admission is \$6.00. She will need to provide the info by April 25, 2017. Mackenzie moved we accept these changes. Shan seconded, motion carried. Lisa Ubach's son has an engineering project: full size pickup with a flatbed. Ron motioned that we don't accept the fair entry because of no place to park the pickup. Jamie seconded. Discussion ensued. Kelly asked to amend the motion so that the entry be parked by the Ag Mechanics. Ron stated he needed to amend the motion and would do so. Jamie seconded, motion carried. Superintendents

are getting the halls set up. Arlene will be cleaning the front of the Bennett Building and rodeo bathrooms.

Cindy Harrison: Needs the 12 comp tickets for Sherwin Williams. Lisa Ubach wants the fans put back in the rabbit barn where they were at. Flower beds will be set up this weekend. Has the signs painted for marking reserved parking. Shan motioned to allow Cindy to purchase letters for parking signs. Barb seconded, motion carried.

Peggy Hansford: Received an email from Dale Bonfield. The school has 4 cafeteria tables. They would like us to trade rental of Floch Hall for the tables priced at \$250.00 a piece. At this time we do not need the tables so Peggy will let them know and thank them for the consideration. Received an email asking if we had a 220 plug in that would pull 50 amps. Will be seeking clarification. National Volunteer Week is April 23rd through 29th. We can run a thank you ad 2 times a week for \$117 or less (2x2). Shan motioned we run the thank you. Kelly seconded, motion carried. Carnival wrist bands are on sale. Need someone at the fairgrounds Monday after fair at 8:00 for Coca Cola to get their displays. Evan and Cindy can both be there. Budd's Cook Shack needs more electricity. Ron motioned that we allow Mike Cooper to arrange for Flerchinger's to add electricity and bill us. Barb seconded, motion carried. Kelly asked Peggy if she saw the royalty itinerary; looks good.
