- a. Pre-Fair: 45 riders total and all went well.
- **b.** Fair Forms: Gwen needs all fair forms turned in. Clubs present turned them in this evening. Others had turned them in before the meeting
- **c.** VET CHECK: Begins this year at 2:00. This is different than what is listed in the premiums.
- **d.** Fair Committees: Gwen checked in with the clubs that are assigned fair duties. It sounds like all clubs are working on what is expected of them.
- **e.** Awards ceremony: Outgoing seniors, if this is their final year parents can write a short speech and present him/her with flowers.
- **f.** Fair Class, Working Rancher: Leaders need to check in with their kids. If they have not roped off their horses they will skip this element of the pattern. This applies to pulling the log as well.
- g. Fair Classes: Last day to scratch classes is Tuesday after the mandatory meeting.
