Live Más Scholarship Fact Sheet

What is the Live Más Scholarship?

This one-of-a-kind scholarship opportunity is for the next generation of innovators, creators and dreamers – young adults who have passions and aspirations that do not fall into the "academic" or "athletic" qualifying categories of traditional scholarships.

In 2018, the Taco Bell Foundation will award more than \$3 million in Live Más Scholarships to young adults (ages 16-24) for post-high school education. Scholarships range from \$5,000-\$25,000 and will be awarded to young people who can clearly explain their life's passion and how the Live Más Scholarship will help them reach their dreams through a 2-minute video.

This year, the Taco Bell Foundation is also introducing a Live Más Scholarship renewal program to continue supporting previous recipients along their educational journey.

Who are the "Innovators, Creators and Dreamers"?

They are the next generation of leaders. Youth on the cusp of adulthood searching for ways to live out their dreams. Their personal goals don't fit into mainstream boxes. They know what they love to do, but they don't know how to turn it into their life's work. With a program like the Live Más Scholarship behind them, they finally have investment in their passion and can turn it into their life's work.

Last year's 100+ recipients came from across 35 states each with unique passions, backgrounds and interests – however they were all unified by their dream of one day changing the world. The top 10 passions were: film/television, performing arts, science/medicine, music, graphic design, fine art, animation, education, photography, and computer science.

How does it work?

- The application period opens at 12:00pm PST on January 15, 2018 and closes 11:59pm PST on March 18, 2018
- All applicants must be ages 16-24 and a legal resident of the 50 United States or the District of Columbia. All videos must be submitted to www.livemasscholarship.com.
- Awards must be used at an accredited post-high school/post-secondary educational programs (including accredited two- and four-year college, universities, vocational-technical, and trade schools) for tuition, required fees, books and course specific supplies.
- First-time Live Más Scholarship applicants must create and submit a 2-minute video that tells the story of their life's passion and why they should be considered for a Live Más Scholarship.
- For the Live Más Scholarship renewal program, applicants must be previous recipients of a Live Más Scholarship and meet additional criteria including: current enrollment in a post-high school educational program, have used 75% or more of previously awarded funds *and* explain in their new 2-minute submission video how they have furthered the pursuit of their passion since first winning a Live Más Scholarship.
