

Clallam County 4-H Shooting Sports Information

ENROLLMENT:

- 1. Members must be enrolled in Shooting Sports project by **June 1**st to participate in 4-H fair exhibition.
- 2. Members must be age 8 by October 1st to enroll in Shooting Sports Projects.
- 3. Shooting Sports Leaders must be certified volunteers trained in Shooting Sports disciplines through attendance at an approved WA State 4-H Shooting Sports certification training.

RECORD BOOK:

Complete a 4-H Record Book with separate project record section for each project.

- Standard WSU Book: Use the journal
- Clallam County 4-H Record Book: Use general project record.

EQUIPMENT:

Shooting Sports Members do not need to provide their own equipment. Shooting sports equipment is available at the club level for participating members. If you choose to use your own equipment, check with your club leader for safety standards and approval.

COUNTY FAIR PARTICIPATION:

- Qualifying members may participate in the 4-H Building at the Clallam County Fair and earn ribbons and premiums. Participation may include: Record Books, Educational Posters & Displays, 4-H in Action, Demonstrations, Club Displays and/or booths, and project equipment.
- 2. The county shooting sports program may offer a "fair" competition with shooting, handling and a knowledge test. Contact your club leader for scheduling information.
- 3. Members entering activities or contests in the 4-H Building must participate in a minimum of 2 hours of herdsmanship duty to receive their fair exhibitor pass.

COUNTY MEDALS:

County medals are awarded based on a member's participation at fair. There is only one medal awarded per every ten members enrolled in each project area (i.e. Archery, Riflery, etc). Youth earn points for each item that they participate in listed below. Points are kept by barn superintendent. **Points are awarded in the following categories:** Herdsmanship, Shooting, Knowledge, Demonstration, Posters (up to 2), 4-H in Action, Project Equipment.

Blue: 3 points, Red: 2 points, White: 1 point. Record Books may be used at the tie breaker.
