1. Take the exit for WA-125/Prescott/Pendleton
2. At the traffic circle go south onto Myra Rd
3. Go 2 miles & turn right onto WA-125
4. Go 3.4 miles & continue onto OR-11 S
5. Travel 10.6 miles and turn left onto OR-11S
6. Go 11 miles & turn left onto Winn Rd.
7. Go 2.1 miles & turn left onto OR-204 E
8. Travel 11 miles & turn right toward Meadowood Ln
9. Turn left onto Meadowood Ln
10. Turn right onto Pine Creek Rd
11. Follow the 4-H Clovers
