Some of the topics were discussed briefly and decided how our delegates should vote.

<u>Teen Rally:</u> Teens in our district (counties from Pierce to Whatcom) participate in the rally where they do activities and workshops for the teens. Each County gets a chance to plan/put on the rally. Eventually it will be our turn and William would like to take 6-8 of our teens and 2 chaperones to the King Co.
