I. Title: Ideas for Living Volunteer Facilitator

II. Nature of Position

The volunteer facilitator furthers WSU Extension's education program to limited income individuals in Skagit County and is responsible to the county Family & Consumer Science Extension Faculty.

Volunteers have the opportunity to receive training related to facilitation skills, working with limited income and at-risk families, and specific life skills topics. Volunteers will receive resource materials and opportunities for ongoing quarterly training.

Training in various curricula will usually be made available through the model of shadowing: a volunteer will observe a class taught by an experienced instructor, then meet with that instructor for Q&A. We find this method to be the most effective as it provides a real time training opportunity.

He/she will work closely with the Program Coordinator to implement educational programs for social service agencies and other selected organizations.

III. Responsibilities

- 1. Facilitate and evaluate educational programs.

- 5. Commitment to attending initial training sessions and monthly meetings.
- 6. Maintain neat, clean professional appearance.
