- WSU Extension Volunteer Beach Naturalists are available to lead or assist with your educational beach walk. A minimum time of 1 hour on the beach is advised.
- Volunteers will:
 - share the beach environment with your group
 - help participants identify plants & animals found on the beach
 - stress the importance of minimizing human impact
 - share/demonstrate good beach etiquette
- Availability of volunteers is limited. A one month minimum lead time is required; requests will be met in the order that they are received
- The field trip itself is no cost, but teachers/leaders are responsible transportation and supervision of children on site. * **Please note** Washington State Parks require a *Discover Pass* for parking.
- Large groups can be accommodated. Subdividing into small groups with one chaperone and 6 8 students per each volunteer is preferred.
- Often wonderful interaction occurs when adults and children explore the beach together.
- To enhance a positive experience for your group, we recommend an in class pre-trip orientation (approx. 45 minutes) given by WSU Kitsap Naturalists and staff..
