REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be a 4-H member in an equine project.
- 2. Must present a Public Presentation at the county contest.
- 3. Must participate in Horse Judging Contests
- 4. Must hand in a completed, up-to-date (through September) Record Book and Kitsap County 4-H Awards Entry Form with Addendum, accompanied by a completed Horsemanship Award Essay Form, with all signatures on all forms, by the awards application deadline.
- *Please note that exhibiting at Fair is not required for this award
