

On-Line Quality Assurance Certification Instructions

All youth exhibitors that plan to sell a market animal at fairs/junior shows in the state of Washington must complete and be certified in a Quality Assurance Training Area. The most common and convenient area to do this is on the Pork Quality Assurance Program. There are others area out there (Beef Quality Assurance, etc.) that you are willing to try. But here are the instructions for the PQA certification.

1. Go to www.pork.org, scroll over the 'Certification' tab and click on 'Program Details'



2. On the right, click on 'Youth PQA Plus - Click Here To Certify Online'. On Children under 13 cannot register by themselves and require a parent/guardian to register, add a child, and manage their training.



3. Click on 'Register' to register a new account-once registered you can begin your training. There is an online manual you can download. The training consists of going through 'units for each of the 10 Good Production Practices, then taking and passing a quiz. <u>Upon completion of you training-print the certificate and keep this with your other animal paperwork.</u> Present this at the time of animal check-in.
