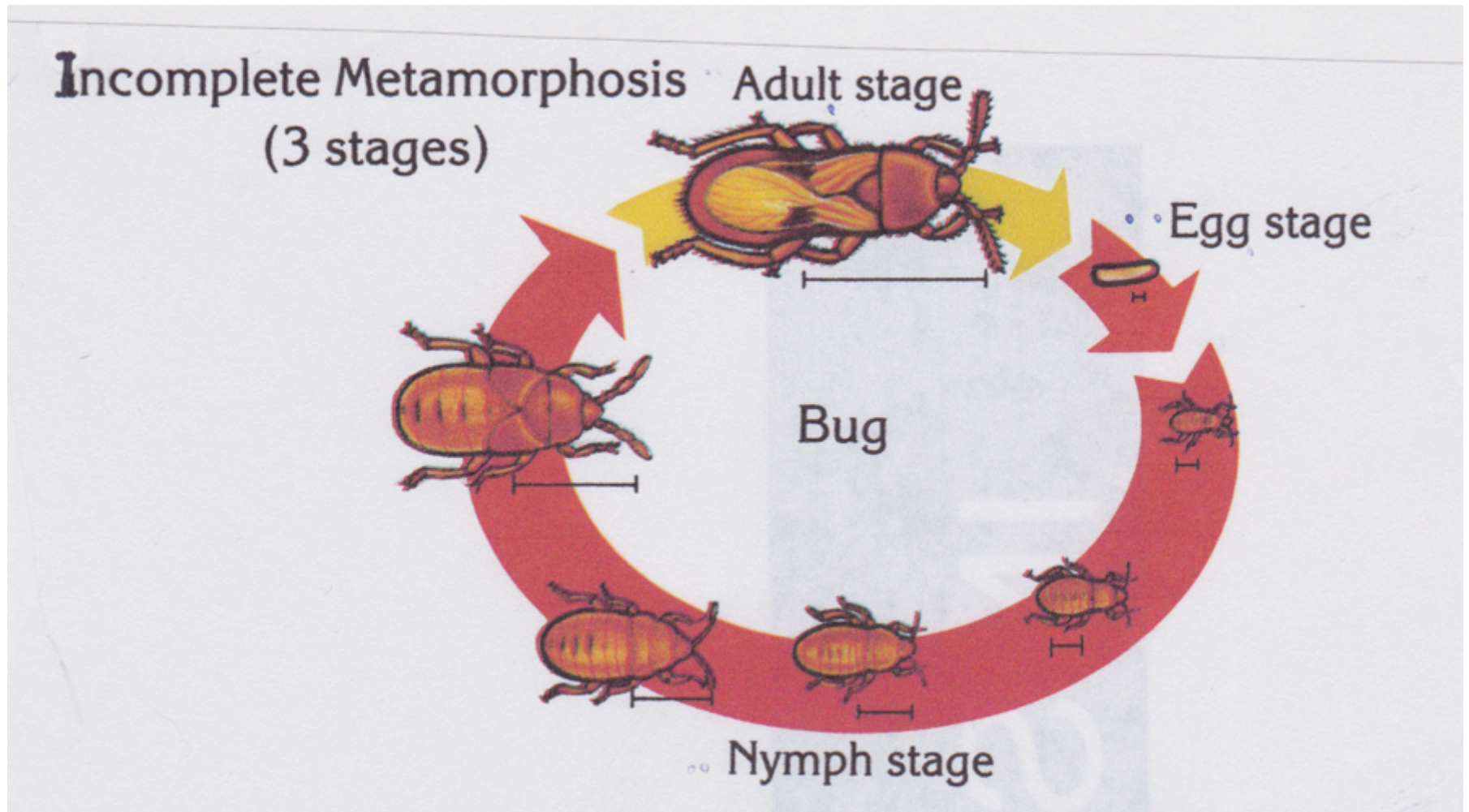


What makes an arthropod an **Insect?**

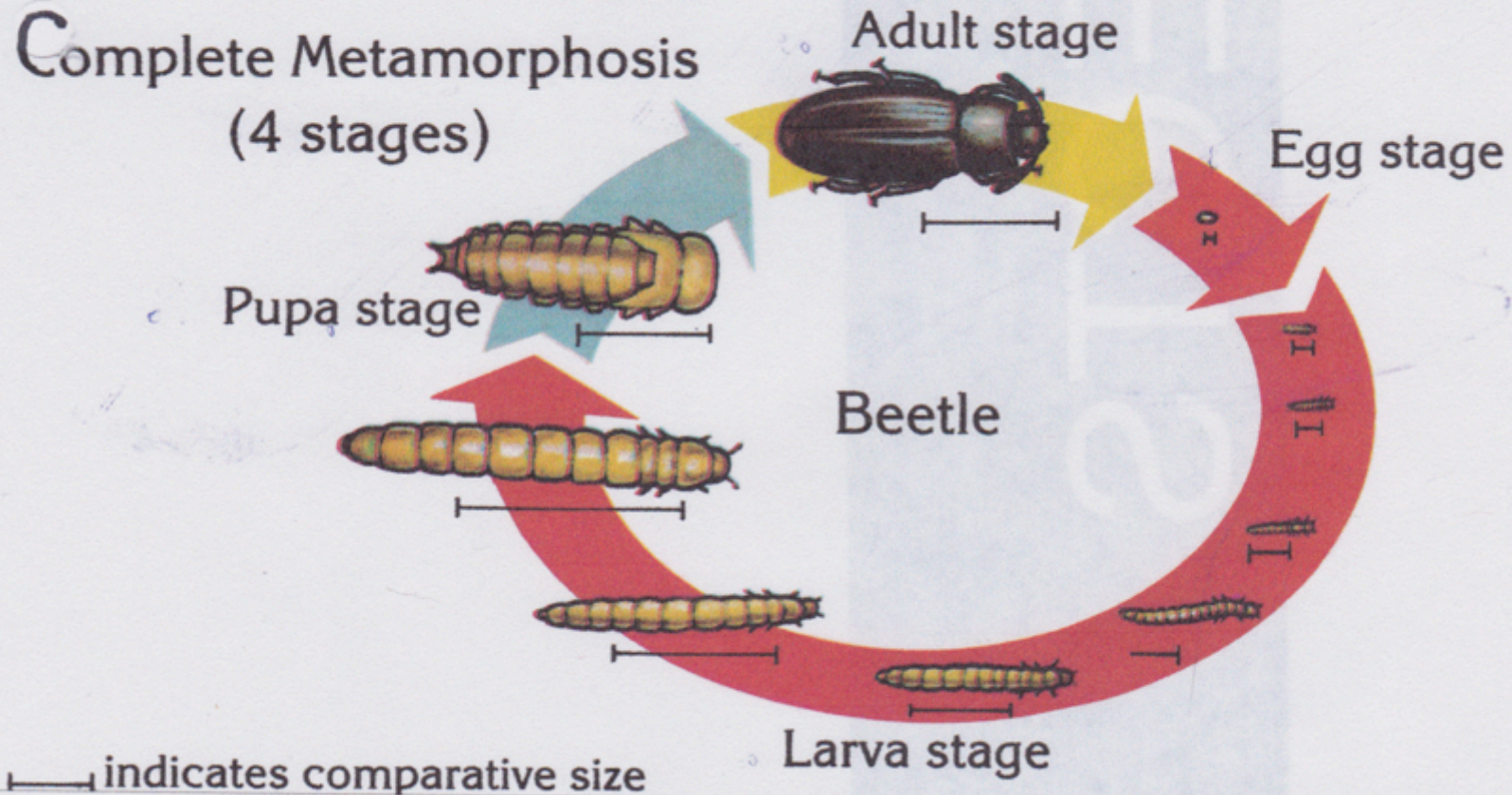
- Insects have:
