

# *Salute to Excellence* *In Recognition of Outstanding Volunteerism* *Lifetime Achievement*

## **Nomination Form**

*Applications must be received by August 1*

### **Guidelines**

1. Eligibility for the *Salute to Excellence Lifetime Volunteer Award* is extended only to those who have served as a 4-H volunteer for at least 10 years or more at the county or state level.
2. In order for a volunteer to receive consideration, all completed nomination materials must be submitted by a nominator, to the State 4-H Office. A volunteer may nominate himself/herself for this award. Out of the pool of nominations, the State Advisory Board will select one nominee for the *Salute to Excellence Lifetime Volunteer Award*. That volunteer will be recognized at the State 4-H Forum Volunteer Recognition Banquet. The nomination will be forwarded to the National 4-H Council. One volunteer will be selected as the national award recipient, from among all the state nominees.
3. Three letters of recommendation, and a nominee application must accompany each completed application. A 4-H staff member, 4-H youth participant, another volunteer, or a parent/guardian must write letters of recommendation. Details concerning the content of the letters of recommendation, and essay are listed below.

- Nominee's positive impact on 4-H youth
- Explain any new programs or fundraising initiatives nominee created

This statement should be no longer than 3 pages in 12-point font with 1-inch margins.

## Letters of Recommendation Guidelines

Please submit three (3) letters of recommendation for the nominee. The letters of recommendation should be written by a 4-H staff member, 4-H youth participant, another volunteer, or a parent/guardian, and address the following items:

- Work ethic and dedication to 4-H
- Demonstrated ability to work with young people
- Recruitment of additional 4-H volunteers
- Advocacy of the 4-H youth development movement
- Dedicated to youth empowerment or youth/adult partnerships
- Professional attitude, character, and morals
