The Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program provides low-income seniors with vouchers to purchase produce from participating farmers markets and roadside stands. **Registration begins Monday, May 7.** Registration continues until all vouchers are gone.

How is eligibility determined?

Eligible applicants must live in Pierce County and be:

- 60 years old or older (55+ for Native American or Native Alaskan)
- Able to pick up the vouchers in person (<u>must</u> have government-issued photo I.D.)
- Low-income (below 185% poverty level)
