SKILLS for PRESIDENTS:

- 1.) Clearly Communicating Organizational Mission and Values
- 2.) Understand Program Policies
- 3.) Making an Agenda
- 4.) Making and Tracking Plans of Action (Calendars)
- 5.) Distilling action items and objectives from a mission
- 6.) Listening Skills & Mediation
- 7.) Understand Methods of Decision Making (Roberts Rules, Consensus, Circle)
- 8.) Delegation

The PRESIDENT

- Helps Council understand and maintain the vision & mission of the organization
- Helps his or her group identify their goals
- Helps his or her group decide on which goals they want to pursue
- Helps the group make an action plan to accomplish their goals
- Prepares the agenda for the each meeting with the cooperation of the other officers.
- Usually serves as chair of the meeting, keeping things focused and moving forward
- Works very hard to make sure everyone is heard and included
- Is a positive leader in carrying out an action plan
- Lead the group in evaluating the success of their goals
- Calls for a vote and participates only in order to break a tie

HOW CAN I HELP AS A PRESIDENT?

- Listen to your members while keeping the meeting focused on the agenda
- Do your best to reach decisions in which everyone is willing to cooperate
- Learn to delegate responsibility and responsibly. Presidents shouldn't be pursing the dream alone.
- Remember: It's better to ask questions than to assume you know answers if you aren't sure.
