The U.S. Transuranium and Uranium Registries is pleased that you are interested in becoming a Registrant in our program. Please review and complete the enclosed documents described below. Copies of the two most recent annual Registrant newsletters are also included. For more information on the USTUR, please visit our website: www.ustur.wsu.edu.

AUTHORIZATION FOR AUTOPSY or USE OF WHOLE BODY — This form authorizes the Registries to perform the necessary procedures after death. It needs to be signed by the donor, the donor's next-of-kin, and another witness.

WSU's INFORMATION AND INFORMED CONSENT — This form gives an overall explanation of the Registries. It needs to be signed by a witness, who may be the next-of-kin.

AUTHORIZATION TO CREATE, ACCESS, USE, AND SHARE HEALTH INFORMATION — This form describes the use, creation, and sharing of your health information for the purposes of the USTUR research study.

RELEASE OF MEDICAL AND HEALTH PHYSICS INFORMATION — This form allows the Registries to retrieve necessary information for the USTUR research study. It needs to be signed by a witness, who may be the next-of kin.

PERSONAL/MEDICAL HISTORY — This form provides general information regarding your employment, medical, and exposure history. It needs to be filled out as completely as possible.

Except for very unusual cases, eligibility to participate as a Registrant in the program is limited to individuals with known and documented internal exposure to one or more actinide elements (e.g. plutonium, uranium, americium, and thorium).

Please complete, sign, and return the enclosed forms. We will review the documents, make a determination for participation and contact you as soon as possible. Upon approval, copies of the forms will be returned to you along with a wallet-sized Registrant identification card. In the interim,
