



Visitor Access to the NHRTR and NRA

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This policy specifies the requirements for casual access to the National Human Radiobiology Tissue Repository and National Radiobiology Archives.

Visitor access defined

Visitors or casual access refers to one-time or ad hoc visits by persons who are not members of the USTUR staff.

Prior approval

Access to the NHRTR is limited to persons with a valid reason for access and must have prior approval by the NHRTR Curator, the Director, or the Associate Director of the USTUR.

Informed consent required for casual access

No visitor shall be admitted to the laboratory or other areas of the NHRTR or NRA without completing the Information and Informed Consent form (USTUR PPM F205).

Staff guided visit

A Registries staff member must be present at all times during a visit of the laboratory and should instruct the visitor(s) orally to specific details of the consent form (USTUR PPM F205) regarding biohazards, radiation and confidentiality.

Photography

Permission to photograph laboratory areas must be obtained in writing by the NHRTR Curator, the Director, or the Associate Director of the USTUR.
