- Build research core facilities


WSU CoP: Major Initiatives 2012-15


- Revise PharmD curriculum

Growth of WSU CoP


- Increase in total number of CoP employees on Spokane campus to 154 from 26 over the past two years
- 8 new tenure-track faculty recruited, 12 nontenure track faculty recruited, and 12 new graduate students added over the past two years
- WSU COP now ranked 35th (out of 130 institutions) by the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy, up from 56th in 2012, in terms of NIH funding
