

# **Filipino Nurses/Health Care Professionals Association (FNHCPA)**

## **Scholarship Program**

### **PURPOSE**

1. To provide financial assistance to qualified students preparing for a career in any health care field.
2. To encourage students of Filipino descent to study in the health care professions.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT**

A minimum of \$500.00 will be awarded per selected student. The recipient will also receive a complimentary one-year membership to FNHCPA.

### **TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP**

**Basic Program:** One (1) merit scholarship will be awarded to a student currently enrolled in an associate or baccalaureate degree nursing program or in any other health care program, **or**

**Post Baccalaureate Program:** One (1) merit scholarship will be awarded to a student in a post baccalaureate program (Master's, DNP, or PhD) in nursing or in any other health care program.

### **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. A resident of Washington State.
2. Currently enrolled within the State of Washington in an accredited ADN, BSN or post baccalaureate program.
3. Must be of Filipino heritage or any student formally adopted by person(s) of Filipino descent. A copy of birth certificate or adoption papers is requested.
4. Must be within one (1) year of graduation from the program.
5. A grade point average of 3.0.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic performance, school and community involvement, and extra-curricular activities.

    - From the Director or Dean of the program or his/her designate
    - From a non-relative

4. This scholarship is a one-time award.
5. The scholarship recipient will be notified by mail and will be honored at an event sponsored by the FNHCPA.
