1. Director of Year 3

- College of Veterinary Medicine, 50% Administrative Position (July 2014-present)
 - Manage curriculum of third year veterinary program
 - Work with Clinical Liaisons and clinical preceptors to ensure delivery of the curriculum in off campus sites (correspondence, site visits, on campus meetings)
 - Supervise course leaders for the 18 courses taught in Year 3
 - Supervise Year 3 Administrative Associate
 - Address academic concerns and issues of Year 3 students
 - Participate in other administrative activities as a member of the Dean's Cabinet
- Position requires 25-30 hours/week effort, including some weekend and evening hours
- Primary accomplishments include implementation of changes to alleviate some student stressors encountered in Year 3 to improve student well-being, and implementation of steps to determine and improve the level of student preparation and confidence for clinical years.
- 5-year goal: facilitate the process of review and revision of Year 3 curriculum
