FACILITIES, GENERAL.

"(c) Storage. Supplies of food and bedding shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect such supplies against deterioration, molding, or contamination by vermin. Refrigeration shall be provided for supplies of perishable food."

There was an uncovered bucket of kibble on the floor of the office/food prep area in the grizzly bear area. There were also uncovered food items in the refrigerator and freezer. Food containers should be covered and stored appropriately to maintain quality by preventing contamination by vermin, dehydration or freezer burn, or cross-contamination. Covering the food containers will also decrease the attraction of flies to the area.

Correct by storing the animals' foodstuffs appropriately from now on.

The inspection was accompanied by the Attending Veterinarian and personnel from the Office of the Campus Veterinarian, as well as specific animal area personnel, and IACUC personnel.

The exit briefing was conducted with the Attending Veterinarian and IACUC personnel.
