## Instructions

Fill in the blanks below as follows:

- **Institution:** Enter the medical school name.
- **Point of analysis:** In each box, enter one of the five factors that are most important to you in choosing a medical school. Examples might include curriculum, level of faculty interaction, location, affordability, and so on.
- **Left hand column:** Beneath the heading “List individual desires or questions,” detail your specific wants and needs relative to each point of analysis. For example, with regard to location you might say, “Can I complete my education close to home?”
- **Right hand column:** In each corresponding box on the right side, list characteristics of the institution that satisfy your wants and needs.
