AUC's **Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (CEI)** is one of the first entities in the Middle East to promote entrepreneurship, launch accelerators, and connect with industry leaders.

AUC's **Venture Lab**—an on-campus startup accelerator—offers study abroad students opportunities to hold an internship, even for just a semester, with startups that are active agents of change in sectors all over Egypt from FinTech innovation, e-commerce, renewable energy and education to gaming, arts, and fashion.

AUC's newly established **Innovation Hub** (**iHub**) will serve as a satellite research center for innovative companies, organizations, and individuals seeking synergies with AUC's leading faculty, students, and alumni.

Through the **Family Business Consortium**, AUC collaborates with a number of business schools from Morocco, Lebanon, and the United Arab Emirates to develop research on the issues and challenges facing family businesses in the region.

AUC's School of Business is home to the newly launched **J-PAL MENA** regional research center focused on alleviating poverty
and improving lives through evidence-informed policymaking.
