Budget Notes

ASCENT projects:

- Funded on an annual basis (typically not multi-year)
- Have periods of performance that are aligned to the academic calendar (Sept-August)

FY2017 Federal Budget will fund the time period from September 2017 through August 2018

FY2018 Federal Budget will fund the time period from September 2018 through August 2019



ASCENT Grant Timeline

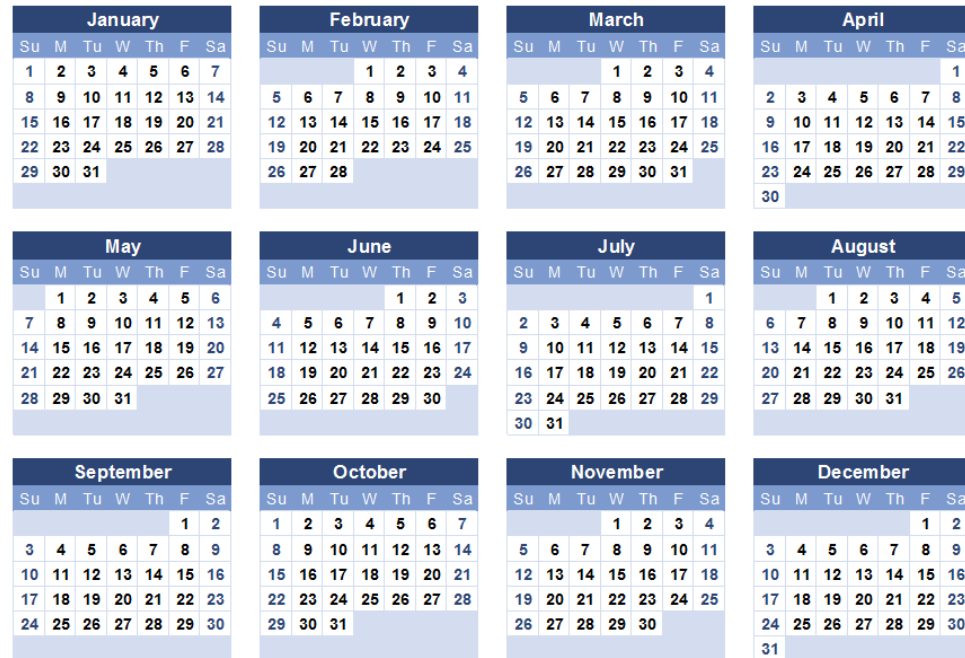
Existing Projects

- **May 15** – paperwork for existing projects submitted to grants.gov

New Projects (based on NFOs)

- May 8 – NFOs go out to COE
- May 30 – COE universities submit responses to NFOs to AEE
- June 5 – AEE selects team
- **June 30** – paperwork for new projects submitted to grants.gov

Important Notes for Principal Investigators

- **FAA are working hard with WSU to complete annual reports and get website up to date**
- **AEE willing pay for publishing fees to have publications be open access (please work with FAA PM to add this to grant paperwork)**
- **All publications must be reviewed by FAA - with a two week review period**
- **Adhere to all reporting requirements in a timely manner**
- **Data Management Plans (DMP) must be submitted**

- **ASCENT funding will be held until website is updated:**
 - Project description (prose)
 - Outcomes (bullets)
 - Participants
 - Outputs (e.g., publications / presentations / posters)
 - Data access information (if DMP states there is sharable data)
