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Prescott School District is a small, rural P-12+ school district in Eastern Washington, situated in the Touchet River Valley, just north of Walla Walla and east of the Tri-Cities of Pasco, Kennewick and Richland. We serve approximately 250 students from diverse backgrounds. We are seeking individuals who want to actively serve the educational needs of all students. Additionally, we desire employees who are passionate, dedicated and willing to learn.

This position represents a unique and rare opportunity to build a strong, effective Agriculture program, including an Agriculture Mechanics program and FFA, from the ground up. Our current Agriculture building and program have not been active for several years. We do not have an active FFA. Our school board and district administration have dedicated substantial funding that will allow the teacher hired for this program to work an entire academic year building the program without having a teaching load. Classes will begin with the 2023-2024 school year. Funds have been set aside to create an entirely new program, as well as renovate the building. The possibilities are endless and exciting.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- An unconditional love of children.
- Develop and implement lessons on general agriculture concepts.
- Develop and implement lessons on animal science and animal husbandry.
- Develop and implement lessons on agriculture mechanics – from basic concepts to industry skills.
- Develop and implement lessons on agriculture, food management and natural resources.
- Integrate agricultural concepts across the curriculum.
- Create and maintain a comprehensive FFA program, including leadership skills.
- Other duties as assigned.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- BA/BS Degree, or higher, in Agriculture or related field.
- WA State CTE Teaching Certificate in Agriculture (or the ability to secure one)
- Multiple certifications preferred.
- Prior agriculture teaching experience is preferred.
- General experience in agriculture.
- Ability to communicate effectively in English; Spanish is preferred, but not required.
- Must be willing to acquire and maintain current First Aid and CPR certification.

- Commitment and ability to work with a full range of students, P-12+, in a small, rural school setting.
- Skill in student management, student discipline and positive behavior support techniques.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Ability to establish and maintain positive effective working relationships with a variety of students, staff, and community in a multicultural, and diverse socio-economic setting.
- Ability to participate collaboratively in teams.
- Ability to continue participation in staff development to maintain professional skills.
- Willingness and desire to serve as an FFA advisor and build an FFA program from the ground up.
- Willingness and desire to create a multi-faceted, wide-ranging Agriculture program.
