Applicants must have a current Washington State endorsement. Washington State CTE certificate is required (or the ability to become conditionally certificated by September 1, 2022). Current First Aide/CPR or ability to obtain within 90 days of employment is required. Classroom instruction includes diverse CTE classes that may include applied math, welding, construction, woodworking, and agricultural mechanics to foster student success in the workforce. Possible opportunity to assist as an FFA Advisor.
