Ridout received his Ph.D. in political science from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 2003, and his research on political campaigns, political advertising and campaign finance has appeared in the American Political Science Review, American Journal of Political Science, Journal of Politics, Political Communication, Political Behavior, Political Psychology, and in many other journals, books and book chapters.
