Counties that send their registrations with one check (this is a good thing) could really help by checking to see that the names are easily readable, as we use the check to verify the name spelling. A typed list of the names and amounts is a great way.
- ☑ **The Registration form can be completed using Adobe Reader (Version 7 and above),- save it to your computer first, open the form using Adobe Reader and fill it out, save and print then mail. If the form does not fill out correctly or when you print it there are errors, this may indicate that Adobe Reader needs to be updated. (This just does not work on Cell Phones)**
- ☑ We can process your credit cards for payment with a **3% service fee**, complete credit card form and follow the instructions on it for sending the information.
