Nomination Form – Volunteer of the Year

Applications must be received by August 1

Guidelines

- 1. Eligibility for the *Salute to Excellence Volunteer of the Year* is extended only to those who have served as a 4-H volunteer for less than 10 years at the county or state level.
- 2. In order for a volunteer to receive consideration, all completed nomination materials must be submitted to the State 4-H Office. A volunteer may nominate himself/herself for this award. Out of the pool of nominations, the State 4-H Recognition and Awards Committee selects one nominee for the *Salute to Excellence Volunteer of the Year*. That volunteer will be recognized at the Annual State 4-H Recognition Event. The nominee will be asked to complete a personal essay about their 4-H experience and it will be forwarded to the National 4-H Council. One volunteer will be selected as the national award recipient, from among all the state nominees.
- 3. Three letters of recommendation, and a nominee application must accompany each completed application. A 4-H staff member, 4-H youth participant, another volunteer, or a parent/guardian must write letters of recommendation. Details concerning the content of the letters of recommendation and essay are listed below.

Please submit the completed nomination form, photograph-600 dpi or greater (if possible; a photograph is required no later than September 15) and letters of recommendation to the State 4-H Office. Submit the nomination materials to the State 4-H Office by August 1 to be considered for the *Salute to Excellence Volunteer of the Year*.

This statement should be no longer than 3 pages in 12-point font with 1-inch margins.

Letters of Recommendation Guidelines

Please submit three (3) letters of recommendation for the nominee. The letters of recommendation should be written by a 4-H staff member, 4-H youth participant, another volunteer, or a parent/guardian, and address the following items:

- Work ethic and dedication to 4-H
- Demonstrated ability to work with young people
- Recruitment of additional 4-H volunteers
- Advocacy of the 4-H youth development movement
- Dedicated to youth empowerment or youth/adult partnerships
- Professional attitude, character, and morals
