Outstanding County Leader Pin and Certificate Guidelines

1. Outstanding leaders from each county will be recognized during the Annual State 4-H Recognition Event. The State 4-H Youth Development Program will present pins and certificates to one honored leader or couple per county.
2. If your county policy is to select three leaders, your county will be responsible for the additional pin cost of \$10.00 per person (the state pays for 1).
3. If the leader is not present at the recognition ceremony, an alternate individual may pick up the pin and certificate for that person; or the award can be mailed to the County Office.
4. Posters/displays for Outstanding County Leader should be made by each county and exhibited at the recognition event..
5. Please submit a picture (**if possible; a photograph is required no later than September 15**) (600 DPI or higher) of your outstanding volunteer electronically.
