- Contest will be held **IN PERSON** on **June 11, 2022** at Evergreen State Fairgrounds, 14405 179th Ave SE, Monroe, WA 98272. Details, including maps, will be emailed to coaches upon receipt of registration.
- Check-in will be in the 4-H Building at 8 am. Contest begins at 8:30 am.
- Registration must be postmarked by May 6, 2022. Details on registration form.

EASTERN NATIONAL 4-H ROUND UP and OTHER NATIONAL CONTEST OPPORTUNITIES

- The 1st place senior team earns the opportunity to represent Washington State at the Eastern National 4-H Horse Round Up. We expect the contest dates to be November 4-6, 2022.
- Information about other national opportunities is available by request. kim.baker@wsu.edu
- Travel for all teams (hippology, horse bowl, horse judging and equine presentations) will be coordinated through WSU Extension with our National Equine Trip Coordinator, Kim Baker.
- Reminder: only the registration fee is paid by the WSU 4-H program. All travel expenses (lodging, meals, airfare, ground transportation, etc.) are the responsibility of the member/team/county.
- A recent change in scoring at the national competition calculates the team's total score by using
 all four contestant scores. Teams of three are allowed to compete, but the fourth score will be
 recorded as zero. Therefore, counties are encouraged to compete with teams of four whenever
 possible. You may combine with another county (or multiple counties) to complete a team for the
 state competition.
- Our state and the Eastern National contest have different age requirements. ENRU contestants
 must be at least 14 years of age but not have reached their 19th birthday as of January 1 of the
