Where? Frontier Park (PC Fairgrounds)

What Time? Judges' Meeting – 7:30, Classes start at 8:00

Cost? Purchase tickets for \$10 each at the show office, 1 ticket at the gate for each class. Better yet, get 3 tickets for \$25 or 6 tickets for \$50! No refunds for unused tickets

Ages Groups? Junior (8-10) Intermediate (11-13) Senior (14-18) Adult (over 18) No exhibitors under 8 years

<u>Rules?</u> Show clothes optional. Boots, helmet, & long sleeves required. All other PC 4-H Horse rules apply

<u>Volunteer Requirements?</u> A representative for each exhibitor must sign up for at least one volunteer position

Performance Classes (8 AM start time)

All classes are offered for the following: Open, Novice (2 gait & 3 gait), Green Horse (2 gait & 3 gait)

<u>Classes Offered:</u> Saddle Seat Equitation, Hunt Seat Equitation, Stock Seat Equitation, English Pleasure, Western Pleasure

Class Order: Will be posted at the show. Showmanship will be the last class of the morning

Driving & In-Hand Classes (after Performance)

In-Hand classes are offered for the following: Novice, Green Horse, Small Equine In-Hand

Classes Offered: In-Hand Rail, In-Hand Dressage, Reinsmanship, Pleasure Driving

Showmanship (won't start before 11)

Classes offered: Open, Novice, Green Horse

Western Games Classes (won't start before noon)

All classes are offered for the following divisions: Open, Novice

Classes Offered: Key Race, Pole Bending, Figure-8, International Flag Race, Barrel Race, 2 Barrel Flag Race
