4-H DAIRY ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Washington State 4-H Dairy Endowment provides two \$500 scholarships. The first is only open to high school seniors. The second is the Scott Hodgson scholarship which is offered to encourage 4-H members to continue their education beyond high school. It is open to high school seniors and those currently enrolled at a community college or university. Submitting one application allows you to apply for both scholarships if eligible. An applicant cannot receive more than one of these scholarships annually. **Materials are due April 1.**

ELIGIBILITY: Current and former Washington State 4-H members are eligible to apply. Applicants must have accumulated at least two (2) years of Dairy 4-H affiliation.

CRITERIA PREFERENCES:

- Applicants enrolled in the Dairy 4-H project for at least three years.
- Applicants that have showed a dairy 4-H project animal.
- Applicants seeking a career in agriculture major.
