# 4-H DAIRY ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Washington State 4-H Dairy Endowment provides two \$500 scholarships. The first is only open to high school seniors. The second is the Scott Hodgson scholarship which is offered to encourage 4-H members to continue their education beyond high school. It is open to high school seniors and those currently enrolled at a community college or university. Submitting one application allows you to apply for both scholarships if eligible. An applicant cannot receive more than one of these scholarships annually. **Materials are due April 1.** 

**ELIGIBILITY:** Current and former Washington State 4-H members are eligible to apply. Applicants must have accumulated at least two (2) years of Dairy 4-H affiliation.

## **CRITERIA PREFERENCES:**

- Applicants enrolled in the Dairy 4-H project for at least three years.
- Applicants that have showed a dairy 4-H project animal.
- Applicants seeking a career in agriculture major.

- 3) Two page 4-H Story
- 4) Two Letters of Recommendation
- 5) High School Transcripts (and college transcripts if applicable)

- Your future goals regarding this opportunity
- How do you plan to attain your goals, contribute to your community and to the future of 4-H?

### **HOW TO WRITE YOUR 4-H STORY (TWO PAGE Maximum)**

- Introduce yourself. Include where you live, and when and why you became involved in 4-H opportunities.
- Highlight your 4-H projects and activities, including major learning experiences, special interests, and achievements.
- Describe how your involvement in 4-H exemplifies each part of the "4-H Pledge."
