4-H INTERNATIONAL FLAG RACE



NSCA (International) Flag Race

A barrel set 120' from the starting line with a 3-pound coffee can filled 3/4 full of sand or soil and centered on top of the barrel, a round dowel, 14" long and a minimum of 7/8" in diameter, placed in the can with a flag wrapped and tacked with a 4" square remaining. A rider crosses the start–finish line, goes down and around the barrel in either direction, and carries the flag back across the start–finish line. Knocking over a can is a 5-second penalty. Knocking over a can and barrel is a 10-second penalty. Dropping the flag before crossing the finish line is a disqualification.



Attach material to a round dowel that is 14'' long and a minimum $^{7}/8''$ in diameter, leaving a 4'' square flag, and insert into sand or soil, standing flag straight up.

3-pound coffee can filled ³/₄ full and centered on top of a 55-gallon barrel.
