Re: Market Animal Health Records

Attached you will find your Market Animal Health Record. Please add a copy to your 4-H record books, which are available through your 4-H leader or from the extension office. All 4-H market project members will be required to turn in a completed copy of their animal's health record at the official weigh-in.



For market beef project, be sure to bring a copy of your brand inspection sheet. Received from whomever you purchased the animal, to turn in at weigh in. Beef exhibitors need to have 2 brand slips at weigh-in., one slip from the producer to the exhibitor and one from the exhibitor to the Ferry County Fair for inspection from the State Brand Inspector.

You will need three completed Producer Affidavit & Market Health Record copies per market project animal. **Animals will not be weighed without these finished records.** One copy is for your home records, one copy goes into the fairgrounds office records, and one copy will go with your market animal to the packer. Fill out form then make two copies of the form you filled out or fill them out individually with the same information. 1 more if you are putting in your record book.

Exhibitors and their clothes should be clean and neat, hair combed; no gum chewing or tobacco use is allowed. Wear jeans or slacks, with a shirt or blouse and boots or shoes that completely cover your feet. No hats, visible undergarments or articles of clothing which display profanity, products, or slogans which promote tobacco, alcohol, drugs, sex, or advertise gang symbols or affiliations are prohibited. Colored clothes are often more practical that white. Clothing should reflect a positive image within the bounds of decency and good taste of the youths and the 4-H program.
