SUBJECT: 4-H Fashion Revue

Please arrive at least 15 minutes early to allow time to fill-out your garment entry tags, turn in your commentary and get yourself ready to model your garment(s). To accomplish these tasks can take 15 minutes - ½ hour. Many of our participants are competing in other Pre-Fair contests this same day. Be considerate of everyone's schedules; be early and prepared to start. If you are also participating in other Pre-Fair events, Fashion Revue takes place first.

Fashion Revue will be at the Ferry County Fairgrounds, in the Carousel Building. For directions, contact the 4-H office. Bring your completed Data Sheet and commentary with you.

During the contest, judging will be on your modeling ability, fit and (re)construction of your garment, and knowledge of your project material. The Judge will ask you questions about your project after modeling. Be able to explain why you chose your pattern, how to care for your fabric, sewing techniques, how to put elastic in properly, etc. Use appropriate pattern and fabrics for your age and skill level.

After modeling your garment(s), you will need to hang them on a hanger, provided by you. Your garment is considered an "official fair entry" and can no longer be handled except by the Judge. The Judge, after all of the modeling is complete, will then inspect and judge your garment on the quality of its construction.

The commentary you create on the data sheet will be read as you model your garment, so you may want to have someone read it while you practice modeling to hear how it sounds.

The 4-H Foods & Nutrition Judging, Clothing Judging, 4-H Public Speaking, Demonstration and Computer Assisted Demonstration Contests will be the same day.

4-H Fashion Revue participants must be enrolled in the 4-H clothing and textiles project to participate in this Pre-Fair competition.
