- All Goat exhibitors are invited to take place in 2 extra fun contests during Fair. The first is **Groom Squad**. Youth enter and form teams. The winning team takes home a cash \$ prize! Youth are also invited to participate in a **Dairy Goat Judging** contest. This earns premium points and qualify you to go on to the Washington State 4-H Fair.
- Poultry Owners! All poultry exhibited at the Fair must be purchased from a NPIP certified heard or be tested for Avian Influenza and P-T before Fair. If you purchased your bird from a feed store keep the receipt and bring it with you to Fair Check In as Proof.
- Parents – We will need a volunteer or two to judge Public Demonstrations during Fair. Training and supplies will be ready for you. All we need is your willingness to encourage our 4-Hers to continue to grow their skills! Contact Abby if you have an interest in giving an hour or two of your time. NO PRIOR EXPERIENCE REQUIRED. Without volunteers their won't be an opportunity for members to practice their public speaking skills and educate the public.
- Seeking Judges! On the 14<sup>th</sup> of August 4-H Members will turn in Educational Posters and we have one volunteer set to judge those. We need one more judge or a series of judges in shifts to help make this a quick process. If you have any time to help judge please contact Abby.
