- 1. Youth applicant must be an enrolled junior, intermediate, or senior 4-H member.**
- 2. Must complete a 4-H Record Book on the county level and earn a Gold Star for completion.**
- 3. 4-H members must submit a scholarship application along with their record book for county record book judging NO LATER THAN 5 p.m., Tuesday, September 4th, 2019. Turn applications and record books into the Extension office. Early submissions are always welcome!**
- 4. Record Book Scholarship recipients will receive a cash award of \$40 at 4-H Achievement Day from Klickitat County Leaders' Council.**
