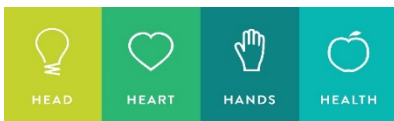

4-H Kick Off Kits

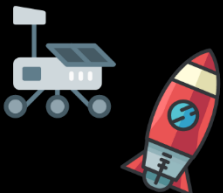
