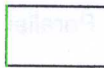

A.) Green, Orange and Violet







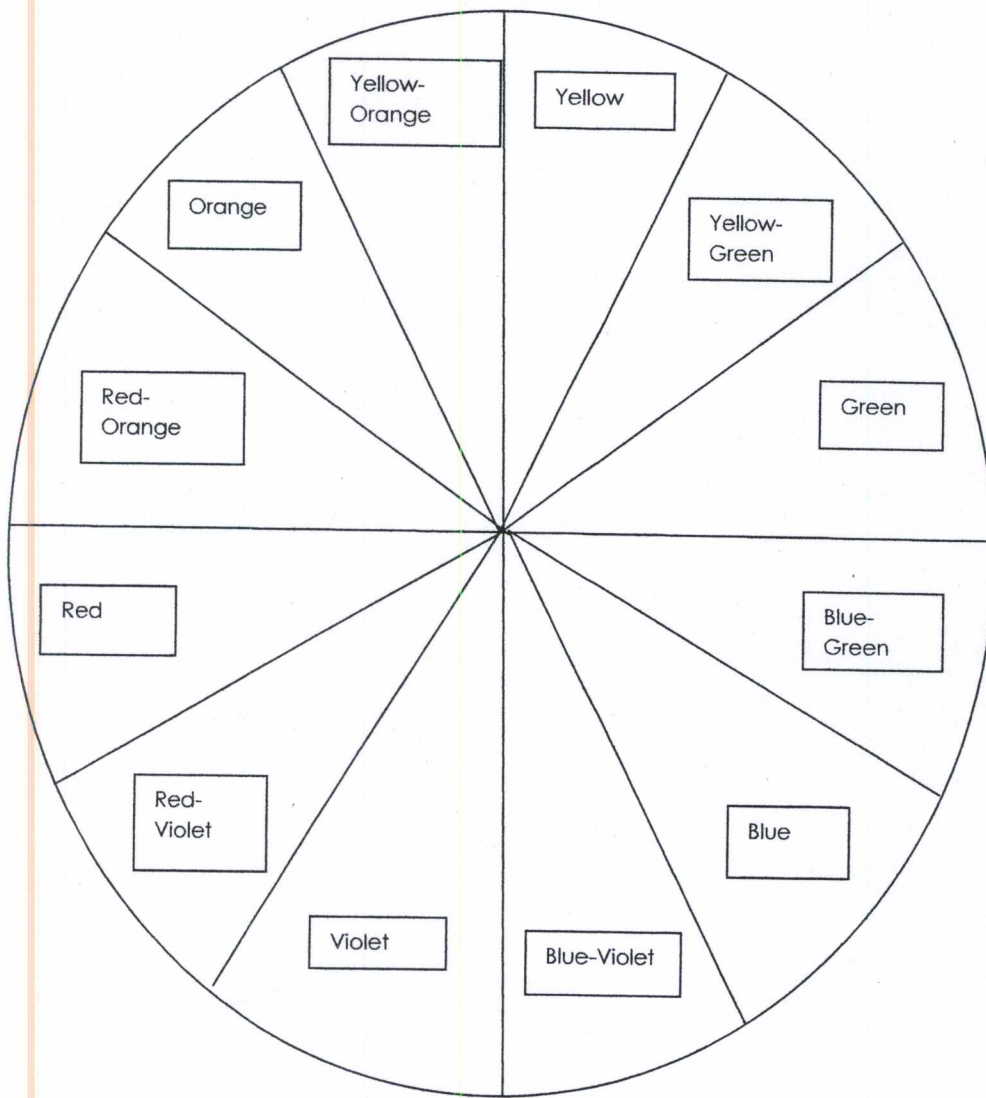
