Friend of 4-H	Extension Office, Aug. 1	Any person or group in 4-H family	Any person or organization/business who has made a significant contribution to 4-H.
Volunteer Excellence	Extension Office, Aug. 1	Any person or group in 4-H family	Any volunteer who has made a significant contribution to 4-H.
Alumni Award	Extension Office, Aug. 1	Any person or group in 4-H family	Has been in 4-H as a member. Application must include a description of the alumni's current involvement in the 4-H program.
Staff Award	Extension Office, Aug. 1	County 4-H Council	Any staff member, county or state level, full or part-time, who works cooperatively with volunteers and whose work has impacted 4-H at both county and state levels.
