4.6/13.4	When posting a photo of a youth in a public space, such as a media release or on a website, make every attempt to use the first or last name, not both, of the youth in conjunction with the picture. For virtual contests or virtual meetings that might include screenshots, ask that youth change their visible name to not include both first and last name before taking screenshots.
7.3.1	A club must have an enrolled project leader for each project offered within that club; youth may choose to enroll in a second club for participation in a project area not available in their primary club.
7.5	A volunteer who fails to enroll for three consecutive years will be required to reapply for volunteer status. Additional training may be required as well.
8.1	All youth must participate in at least one county level educational activity to be eligible to exhibit at the Evergreen State Fair. If your club would like to host an activity, contact your program leader.
8.10	Certification in Youth for the Quality Care of Animals is required for all juniors and older youth raising livestock animals (pig, beef, sheep, goats, dairy, market rabbits, and poultry) as 4-H projects. It is recommended for youth with fiber-producing animals. The training is available both online and in person. Financial support is available if needed.
