The **EVOLVE** Program is a combination of education and recognition that will leave you with more skills and knowledge to run your club, project, program, or other group.

The goals of the **EVOLVE** Program are to:

- Provide quality education focused on attractive topics for leaders of youth groups
- Increase the quality of leadership and content of youth programs
- Recognize volunteers for their commitment to increasing the quality of programming

The **EVOLVE** Program consists of educational offerings in four major categories:

Each of the four main areas has various workshops that will be offered on a rotating basis over a three-year period. Upon completion of a prescribed course of education, volunteers will receive a certain level of recognition. Each category's prescribed course will contain some required and some elective workshops.
