- Baking rules- All entries are expected to be made from scratch; no mixes permitted.

 Class T: Models-Lego, automobile, airplane, etc., remove Legos and add NEW CLASS and LOTS: CLASS Y: LEGOs Regular or Duplo LEGOs may be used. Models are judged on stability, creativity, design, appearance, and appropriate level of difficulty. Include a written explanation of what the model is, why you chose to build it, what would you do different next time, what you plan to do with the model, and any other important information you would like the judges to know. LEGO models from scratch may include design plans as part of their display.
